## PROJECTS STATUS

### **Biodiversity**

All day event on 21st July was very successful. This would be good to make an annual event. Lorraine and Matt need more help as it is a big event to manage.

#### **Community Garden**

Garden is growing well. Mary would like to attract families be involved with the garden. They have invested the profits from their open day in some tools.

#### **Energy**

Update on October workshop. Plan into wider calendar – see below.

#### **Get Growing**

- Squash, pumpkin and sunflower seeds have been sold and many plants sold, not just tomatoes. The surplus 500 tomatoes were snapped up by growers whose own plants had been eaten in the invasion of the killer slugs. 1,500 distributed altogether.
- Could enquire as to fate of people's plants on SusWoT mailing list. Any successful slug remedies.
  - o Action: Fran to include with distribution of these minutes.
- Should we consider other plants that will be more tolerant of soggy summers? Depends if this is likely to be ongoing.

#### Market

- Progress on finding additional stalls.
  - New stall from Tynings allotment. Also a couple more enquiries: one craft, one cakes and preserves, one Oxfam shop stall.

What SusWoT support in next 3 months would be most useful to market?

- Distribute flyers and advertising. Make information as specific as possible with dates, details of stalls present.
  - o Action: Alex to organise distribution.
- Still working on management of Carlton Court to move the market there, could maybe use the footpath the extend the area and get a more workable number of stalls.

### SusSwap

Tracy does not want to continue doing it. An event at last year's flower show was quite successful, it may be that a selection of one-off events would be a better way than the regular stall.

### LOCAL PLANNING ISSUES ETC.

#### Tesco's

Still waiting for them to organise a meeting. They don't need planning permission but they do need a Traffic Regulation Order which could be challenged by those concerned.

#### **Post Office**

There was a petition in the Post Office about it closing, but some uncertainty as to whether this is really the case, but the lease has been up for sale for some months.

#### **Costa Coffee**

Other Costa Coffee's in the city that have opened without permission have now been approved, so this is likely to set a precedent for other branches.

There is another application for a coffee shop in Blockbusters.

### Westbury Road bus lane

Council won't even think about this while there are roadworks in North View, which they argue modifies the traffic flow too much to be able to make a valid assessment.
