Attach film to Single Glazed Windows

<u>Issue</u>

Single glazed metal framed Crittall windows in listed medieval building have significant heat loss and are draughty due to poor fit in the frame. Replacement with double glazing is not permitted due to listed status. Secondary double glazing is being planned for the future.

<u>Action</u>

Apply temporary secondary double glazing film in winter. Attach to windows with double sided tape and shrink film with hairdryer to produce tight sheet. There is a bit of a knack to this ...

2 x Wickes Seasonal Secondary Glazing Film - 6m² @ £6.50 = £13.00 for 6 medium windows.





<u>Effect</u>

Very effective at stopping draughts as the window is completely sealed.

Room feels significantly warmer.

There can be a problem getting the film to stay adhered to the tape, especially if windows are uneven shape.
